Dear Sir:

The following list consists of items known to have been disposed of at the Ramsdell Quarry site:

- 1. Wire banding
- 2. Culvert pipe
- 3. Brick cement block
- 4. Concrete
- 5. Dirt from excavations
- 6. Roofing materials (both asphaltic and transite).
- 7. Shingles
- 8. Wood (dunnage)
- 9. Railroad ties
- 10. Plaster dry wall
- 11. Road materials i.e., blacktop, gravel, etc.
- 12. Viber containers
- 13. Used tires

All metal scrap accumulated during any construction is taken to the Scrap & Salvage Yard where it is then sold to the highest bidder.

To the best of our knowledge, no explosive contaminated wastes have been recently deposited into the quarry. Any wastes of this type are taken to an approved site and destroyed in an approved manner.

No chemicals, solvents, corrosives, hazardous or toxic materials are presently disposed of in the quarry.

In regards to the possibility of having to drill monitor wells, we would like to bring to your attention that we have had a recent (1977) Geohydrological Survey done in which some of the abandoned wells in the vicinity of the quarry were sampled and tested to check the ground water quality.

Results of the survey showed that no adverse affects of the ground water quality have occurred.
