Dear Sir,

On August 22, 1990, this writer met with you, representatives from the Environmental Design Group and other Arsenal representatives and conducted a final closure inspection to determine if the facility had met the closure requirements as required by OAC 3745-27-10 (effective July 29, 1976).

Our inspection revealed that the requirements for closure of this solid waste disposal'facility under the rule stated above have now been completed (see attached inspection report). Final cover, grading and vegetative cover have been completed to the satisfaction of the agency.

Please note that two (2) <u>recommendations</u> are noted on the attached report which we would like to see implemented at the facility before the winter months approach; i.e., numbering and labeling the groundwater monitoring wells and application of additional gravel to the access roadway turn a round.

This writer appreciates the cooperation extended by your staff and consultant in accomplishing an exeellent final closure.
